The East Nantmeal Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting on the above date at the Township Building. Present were Supervisors Jenkins, Cochrane, and Wren. Solicitor Oeste was also present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Jenkins.

Motion by Cochrane and seconded by Wren to approve the minutes of March 13, 2013 Regular meeting. All in favor.

Motion by Cochrane, seconded by Jenkins to accept the treasurer's report. All in favor.

Chuck Cutlip delivered a routine building inspector and zoning officer's report. Details can be found in the March 27, 2013 Building & Zoning report filed in the Township office.

New Business:

Motion by Jenkins and seconded by Cochrane to authorize Dave Maugle to prepare road bid package at no cost to the Township. All in favor.

Motion by Jenkins and seconded by Wren to purchase an Exmark 60-inch cut lawn mower on the state program from Frames Power Equipment at a cost of \$8,935. List price \$12,764. All in favor.

Chairman Jenkins mentioned West Vincent Township enforcement notice to the Greiner business on Conestoga Road (Route 401).

Supervisor Wren mentioned discussions with Somerset Nursery and PennDOT regarding landscaping the “triangle” at Fairview Road and Rt. 100. The Board is in support of landscaping the triangle.

Mr. Wren also noted that the pipeline website indicates that the sponsors have suspended the project.

The Board is in favor of placing a banner on the Township property to advertise the yard sale on June 15<sup>th</sup> that is being hosted by the Historical Commission and the East Nantmeal Land Trust.

Supervisor Cochrane gave an update regarding the website. Mr. Cochrane stated that a decision about the website would be made by the end of April.

Motion by Jenkins and seconded by Cochrane to pay bills from the General Fund in the amount of \$18,490.90 and Open Space Fund in the amount of \$2,850.00. All in favor.

Motion by Jenkins and seconded by Wren to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m. All in favor.
