Due to the COVID-19 health emergency, the East Nantmeal Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting by teleconferencing on the above date. Present were Supervisors Loomis, Frame and Wren. Solicitor Oeste was also present. Secretary/Treasurer Brumfield was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Chairman Loomis.

Supervisor Wren reported that the Ordinance Review Committee met by Zoom videoconferencing in August and September and that the review of the Zoning Ordinance is complete. Wayne Grafton is preparing the final document which will be sent to the Planning Commission for review.

Ed Bacon reported that the Planning Commission will meet by Zoom videoconferencing on September 10, 2020 at 7 PM to discuss the proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment for high tunnels.

Maureen Noonan reported that the Historical Commission and the consultant have begun the Historic Resources Survey project.

The Environmental Advisory Council reported that it is the process of scheduling the fall road clean-up. The Boy Scouts will be contacted to determine if they can participate considering the COVID-19 restrictions. Chairman Loomis stated that the EAC should pick a date when the roadside vegetation is no longer green and the weather is not too cold.
