The East Nantmeal Township Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting on the above date at the Township Building. Present were Supervisors Edward P. Loomis, Jr., David L. Frame, and Tyler E. Wren.

Call to Order

Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Building Inspector's Report/Zoning Issues

Matt Hoffert, Zoning Officer and Building Inspector, was not present and did not present the Building Inspector and Zoning Officer's Report. However, a written report dated August 3, 2021 was submitted by Mr. Hoffert, which is on file in the Township office.

Planning Commission

Diana Cormack, Chair, reported the Commission will meet on August 12, 2021.

Historical Commission

Maureen Noonan, Chair, reported that the Historical Commission met on July 20, 2021. Approved minutes will be posted on the Township website.

The review of the Historic Resources Survey Project forms continues, with any adjustments needed being sent to RGA consultants for the draft.

After County inspections, the historic iron bridge on Warwick Furnace Road (County Bridge #199) remains open two weeks after being hit by a car on the right sidewalk and on the upper portion of a vertical post on its left middle side. A red strip has been placed over the "One Lane Bridge" on the sign next to the bridge.

The Historical Commission will not meet on August 17, 2021.

Supervisor Wren stated the committee met August 10, 2021 to review and revise the Comprehensive Plan. The Committee will meet again on September 7, 2021.
